Marissa and I were able to go to Hong Kong to minister in the CCOWE Young Pro Camp and there, we were able to share the gospel to two Cantonese who never heard it and they received Christ. I was able to go with a missionary to Medan, Indonesia to train the leaders and pastors for evangelism to the Muslims using orality. There, I was able to lead a rich Chinese family of four to Jesus by divine appointment.

Last December, our family was able to go to Taiwan and we were able to bring eleven Taiwanese and Chinese Filipino to the Lord. I trained my two sons to share the gospel in Mandarin and they brought two to Jesus Christ. I praise the Lord for the privilege to preach and minister in Hong Kong, Taiwan, Indonesia and many cities in the Philippines. I am also able to join a mission conference, evangelism among Hindus and Buddhist seminar and Harvest Connection facilitator's training. To God be the glory!
